The data is from German (adult) population. The sample has engineers, doctors, academicians and students. The paper details more about the data demographics.

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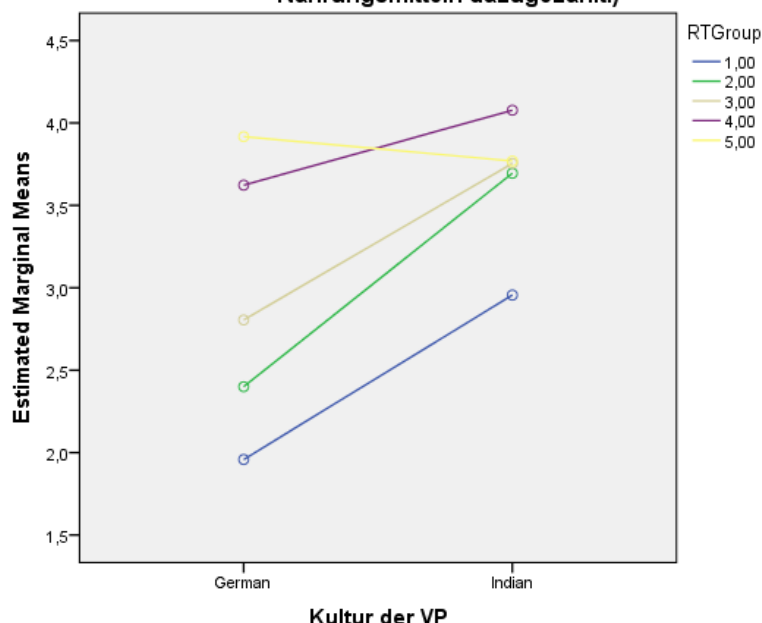
