## Integration and Development of Generic Competencies into Malaysian Higher Education Context: Review of the Literature

## Abstract

The current review study has presented the challenges of developing and implementing generic competencies in the context of higher education institutions in general and Malaysian higher education in particular. The results of the study revealed that institutional support and commitments should be assigned to increase the awareness of generic competencies and give more value to these skills to affect teachers' and students' perception.
